

Updates and Discussions

- **Portables for Schools**
 - Only two portables available for all schools.
 - One structure will remain at the Holy Rosary school.
- **Grade 8 Hoodies**
 - Estimated cost: \$30 per hoodie.
 - Total students: 43.
 - Agreement to contribute to hoodie expenses. Spirit wear order forms are out and Grade 8 can get hoodie for \$20 instead of \$50 with CSCC contribution.
- **Parent-Teacher Conferences**
 - Jackets and books will be given away to those that need these items.
- **Budget Adjustments**
 - \$2,000 to be relocated from the teacher fund.
- **Refreshments and Supplies**
 - Beverages: Pepsi, Diet Pepsi, and Crush mix.
 - Supplies: Plastic cutlery and a price list to be checked at Costco.
 - Louisa will purchase beverages and utensils etc. Catherine will purchase food with her mum and her mum will cook the food for sale.
